



Supplementary Figure 1. The search strategy for systemic sclerosis studies that recorded a prevalence of scleroderma renal crisis (SRC).





Supplementary Figure 2. Funnel plot for the frequency of scleroderma renal crisis according to sample size in the studies where the distribution of IcSSc and dcSSc has not been specified (overall SSc). The plot is graphed vertically according to sample size. There may be publication bias for the non-classified SSc rates with one study appearing to be an outlier.
